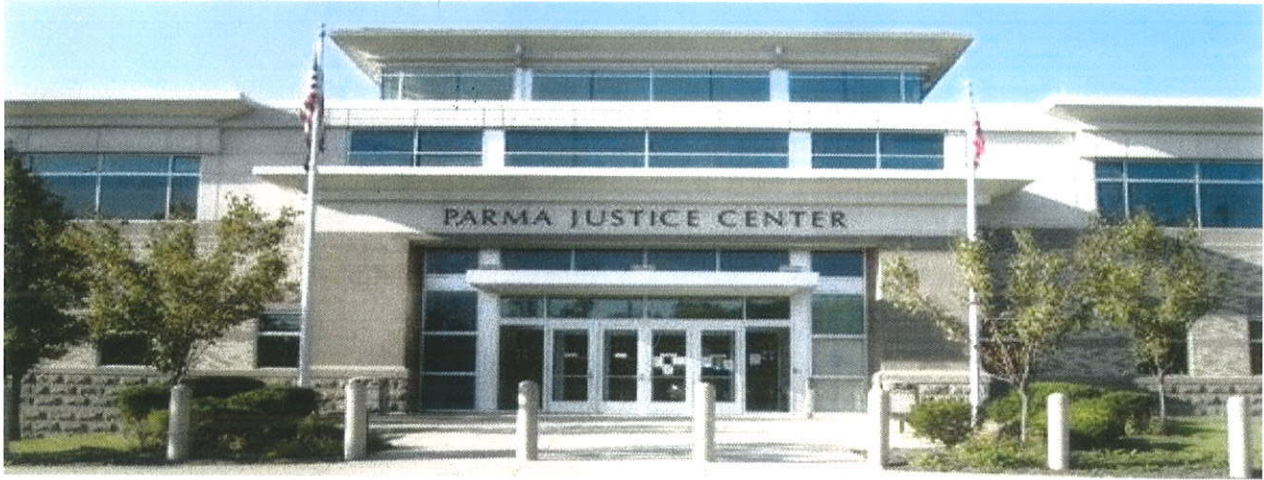

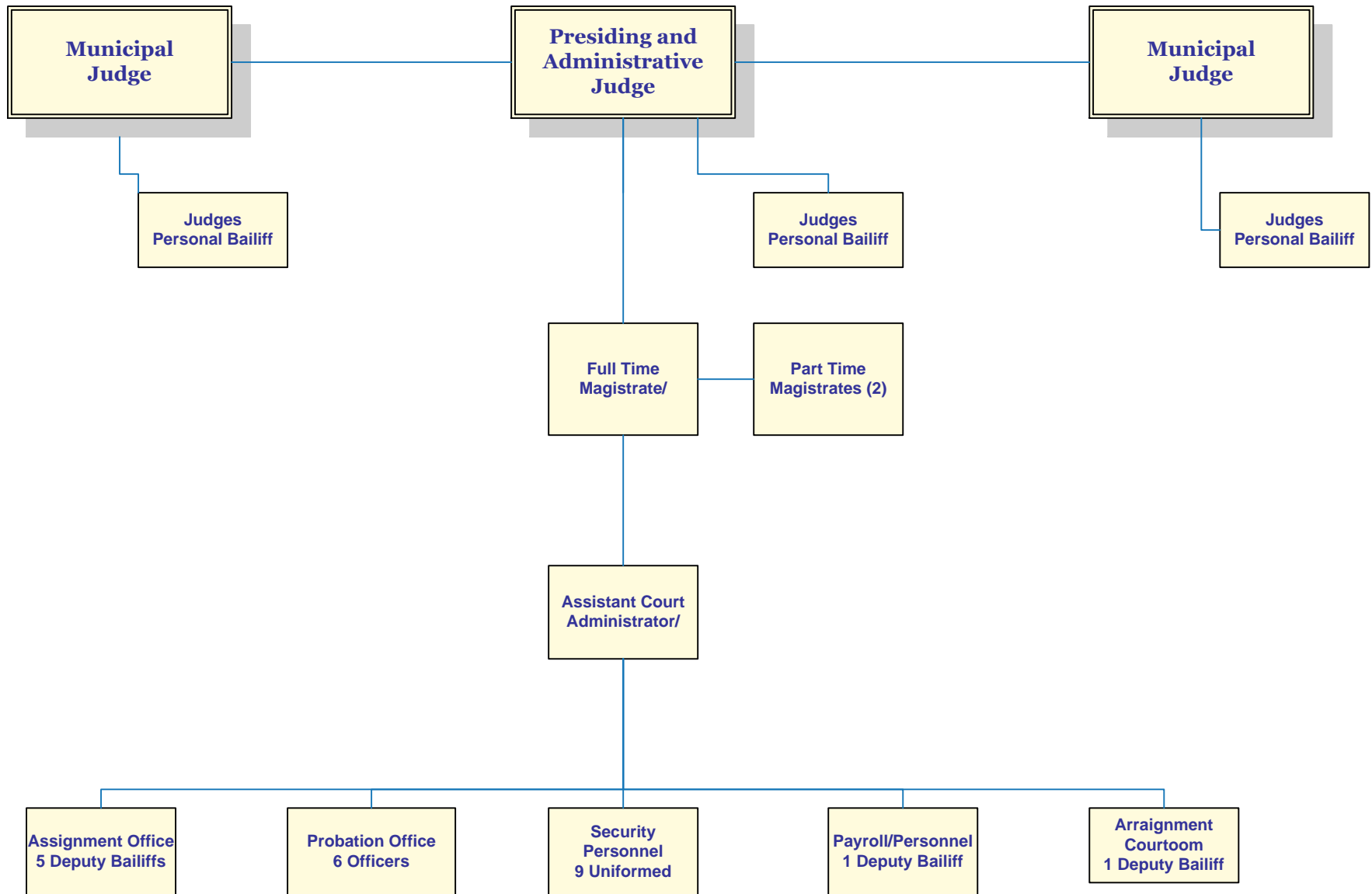

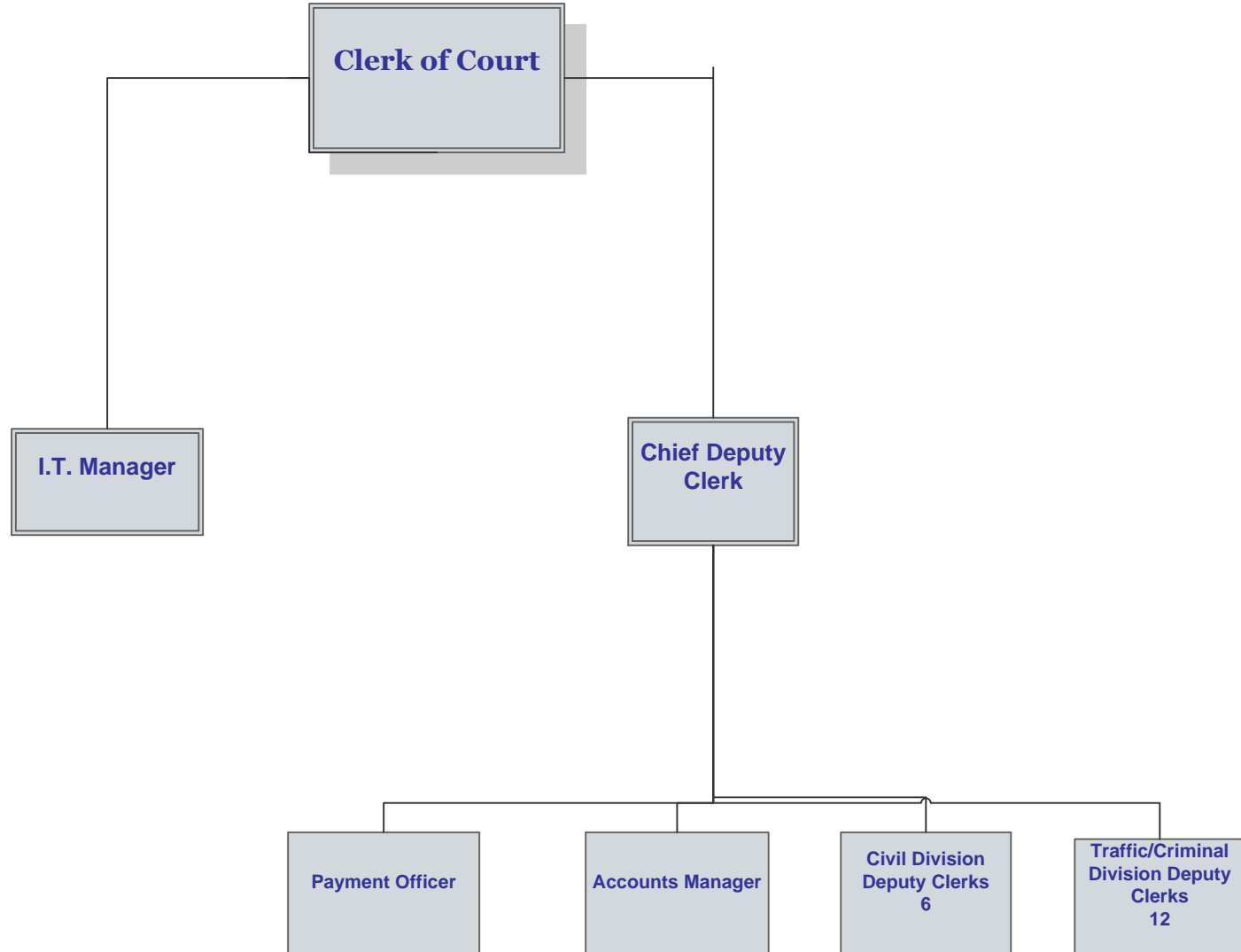
Organization Chart

SECTION ONE
FINANCIAL

State Imposed Court Costs

Municipal courts are created by state statute in Ohio. The Ohio Revised Code sets forth how the court is to collect and distribute money derived from the fines, fees and costs. It also mandates that the Parma Municipal Court collect money for the State and for Cuyahoga County from virtually every case filed to fund one county and various state-run programs.

The mandatory court costs and program funded are as follows:

In addition to the above court costs required by state statute, the Parma Municipal Court is mandated to collect \$5.00 on every moving violation cited on a traffic ticket to support the Cuyahoga County Regional Information System (CRIS).

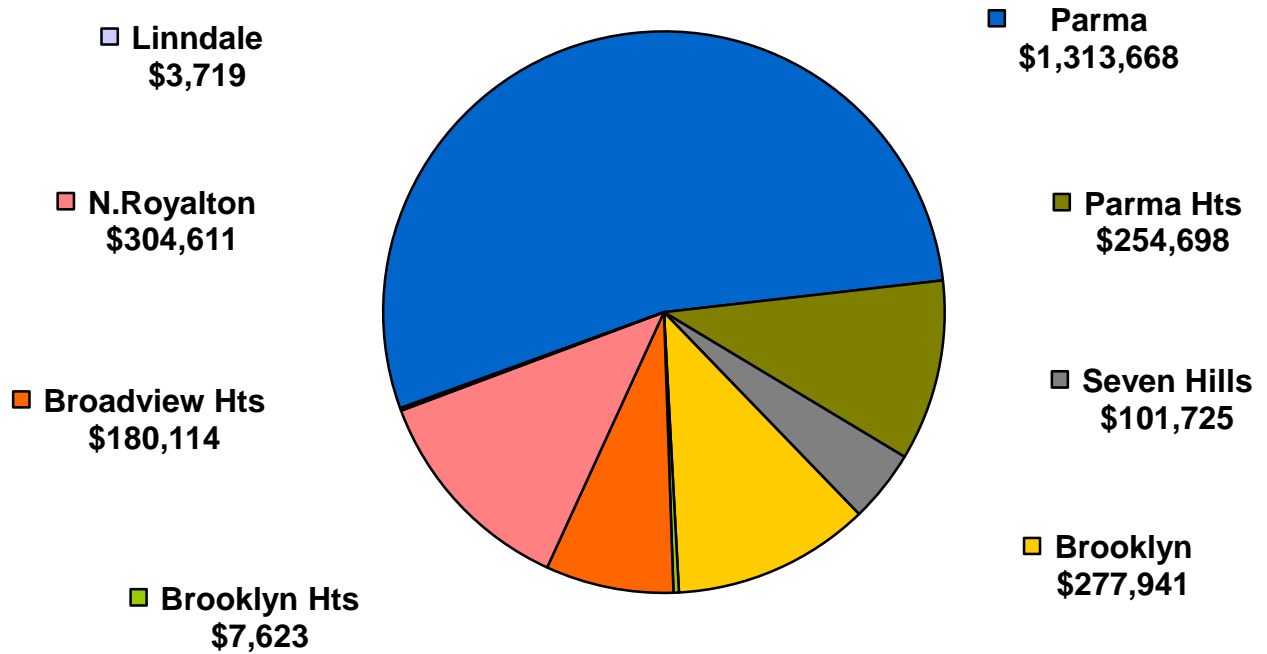

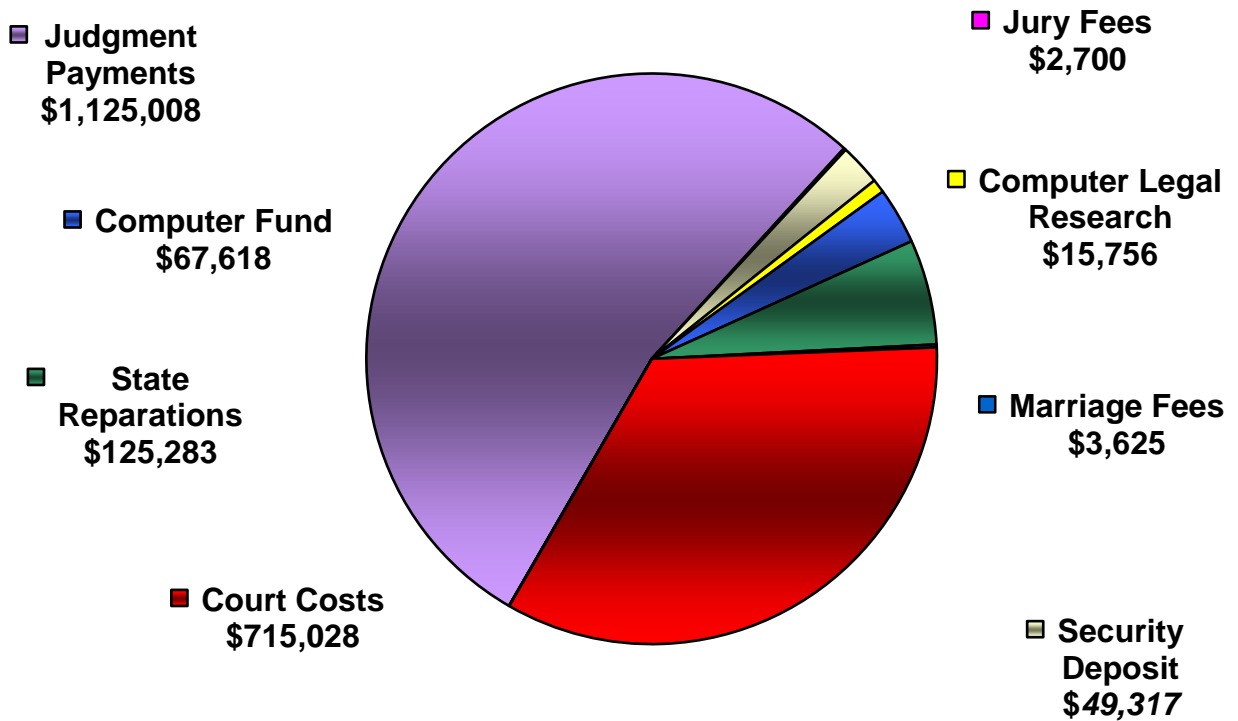

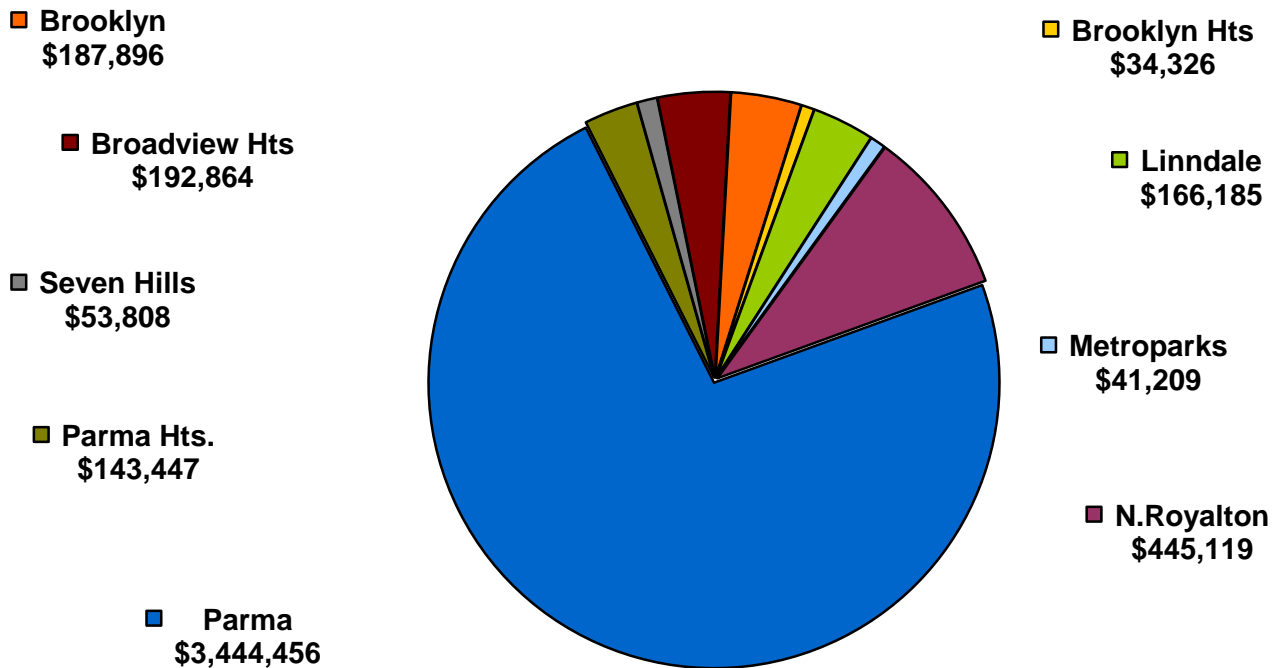
Civil REVENUE by Defendant's Municipality



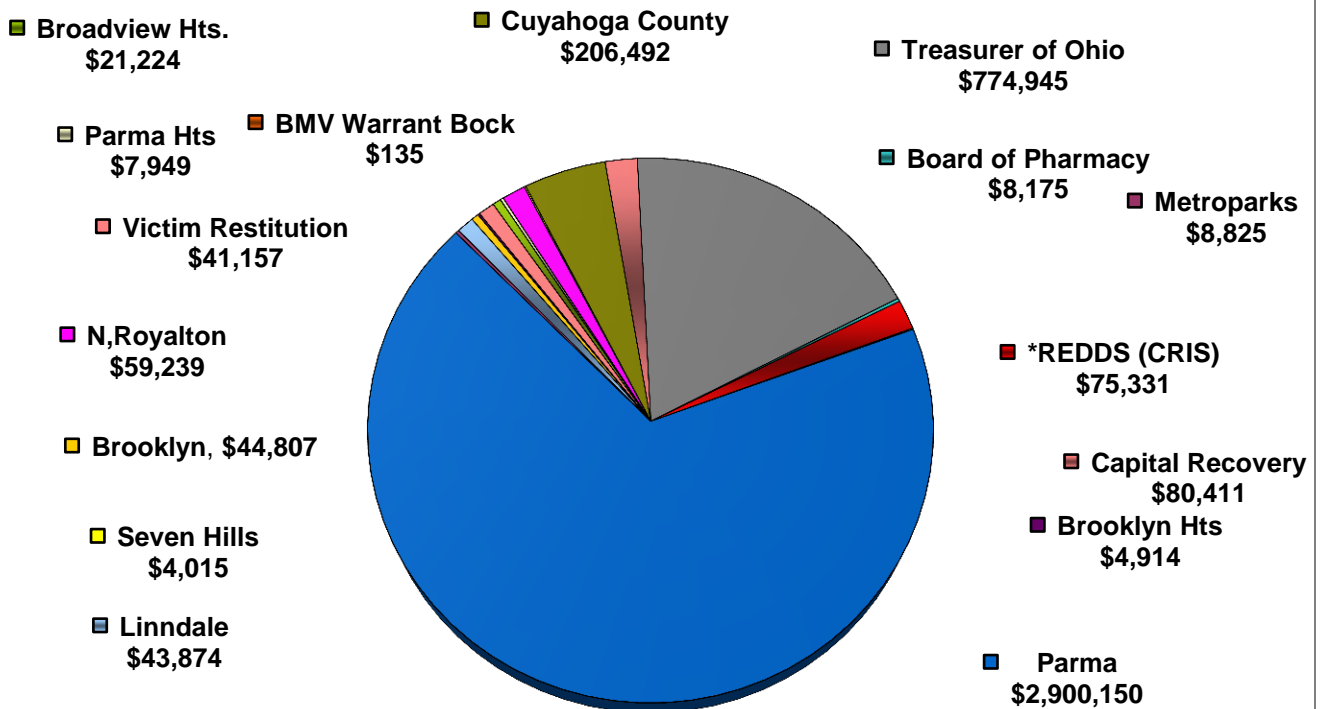
Civil DISBURSEMENTS by Type



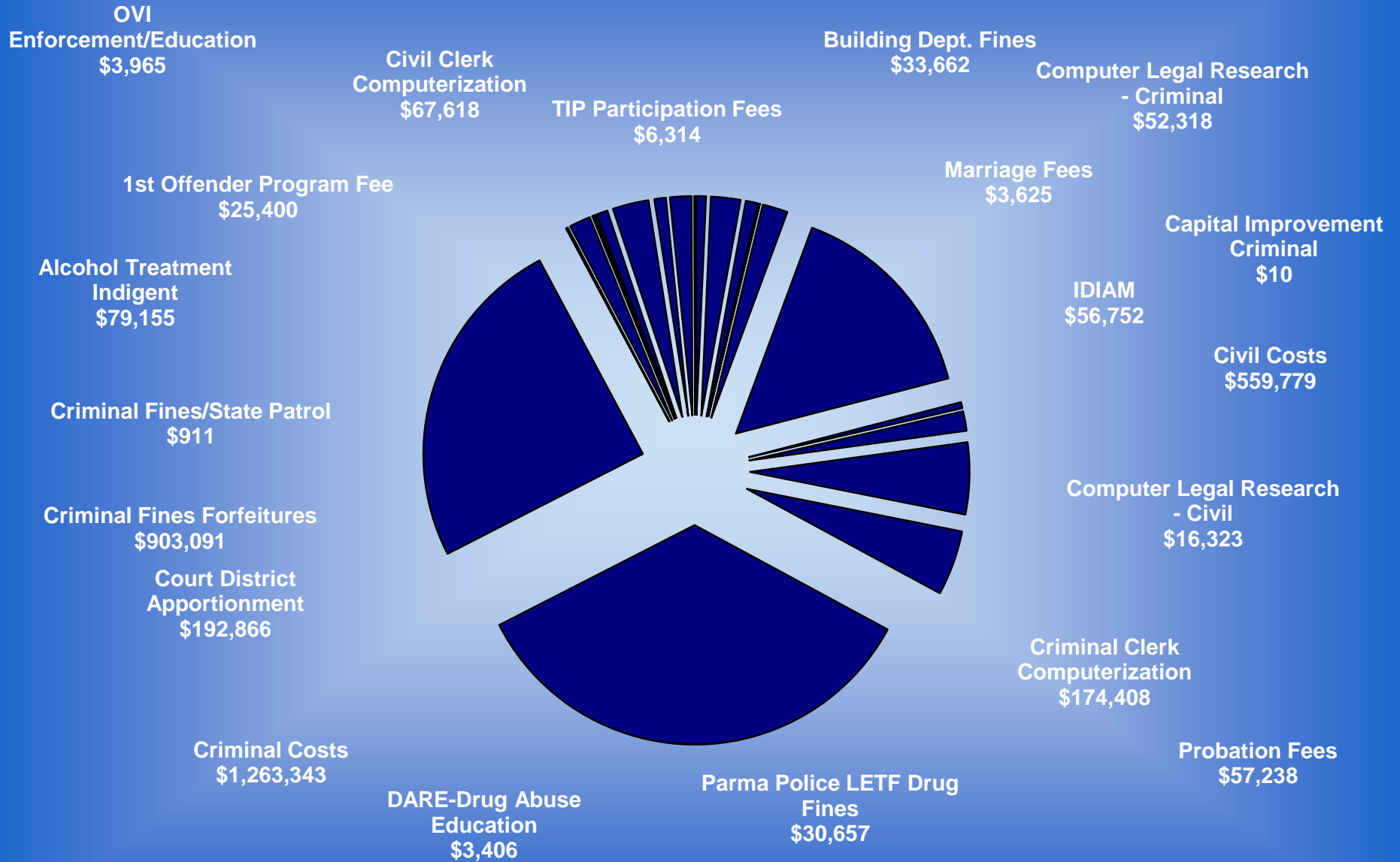
Traffic/Criminal REVENUE by Originating City

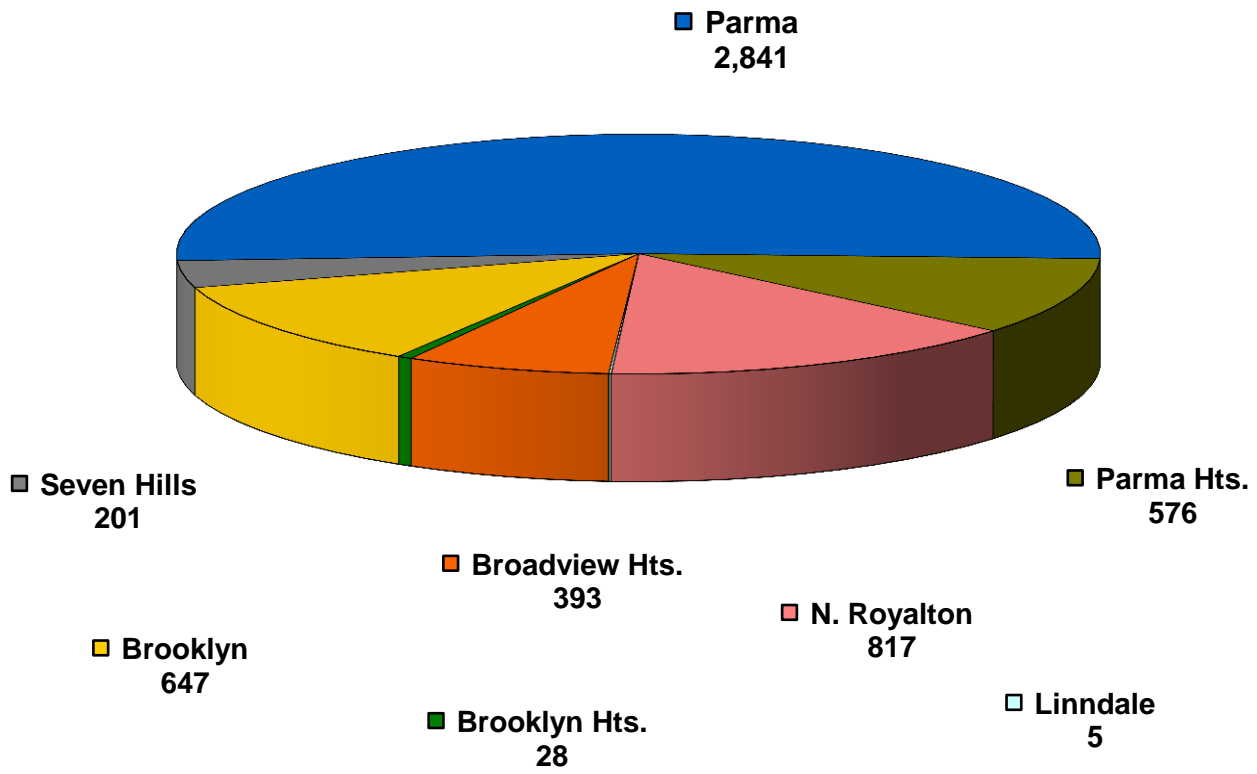

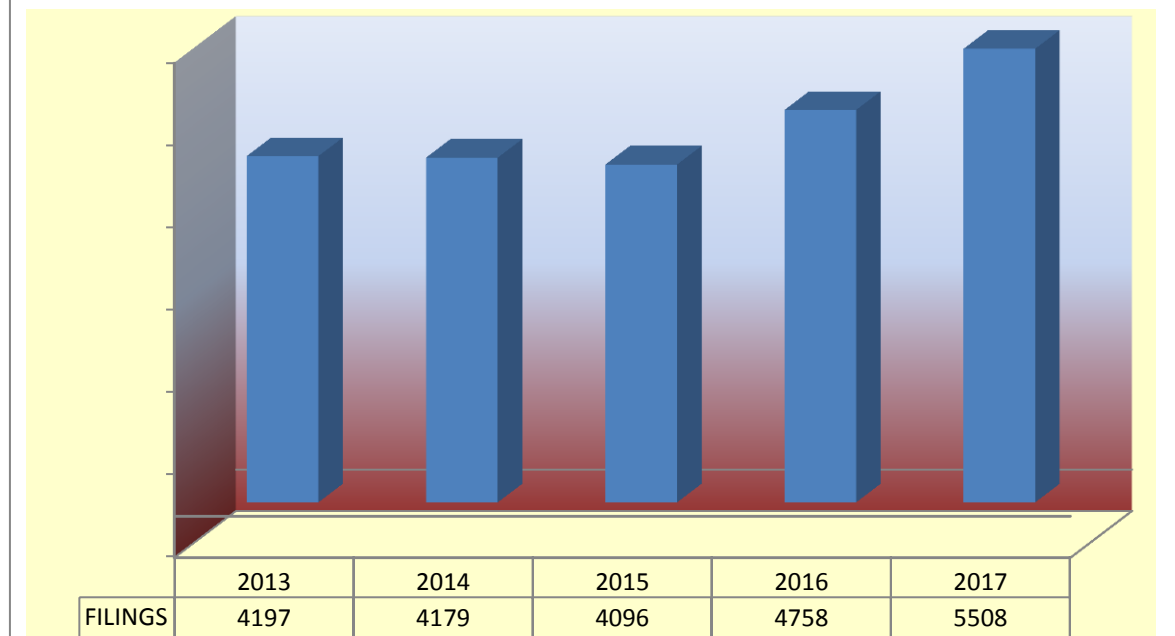

TOTAL CIVIL FILINGS BY YEAR



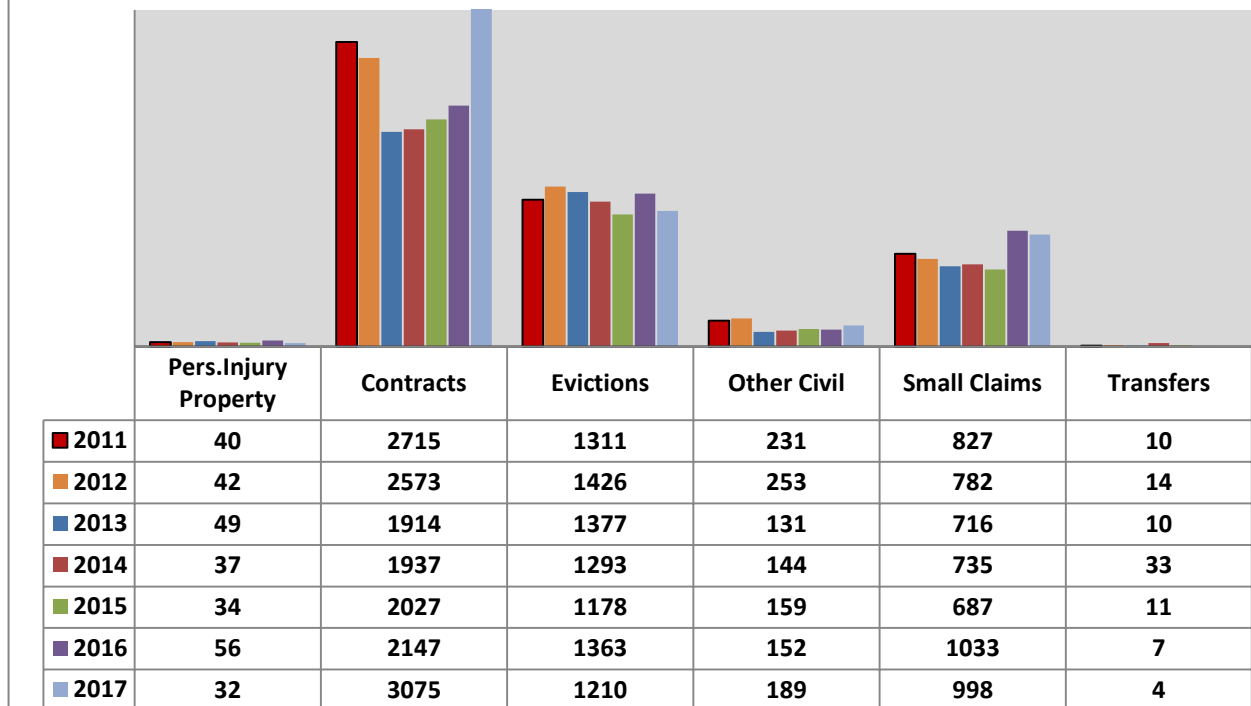

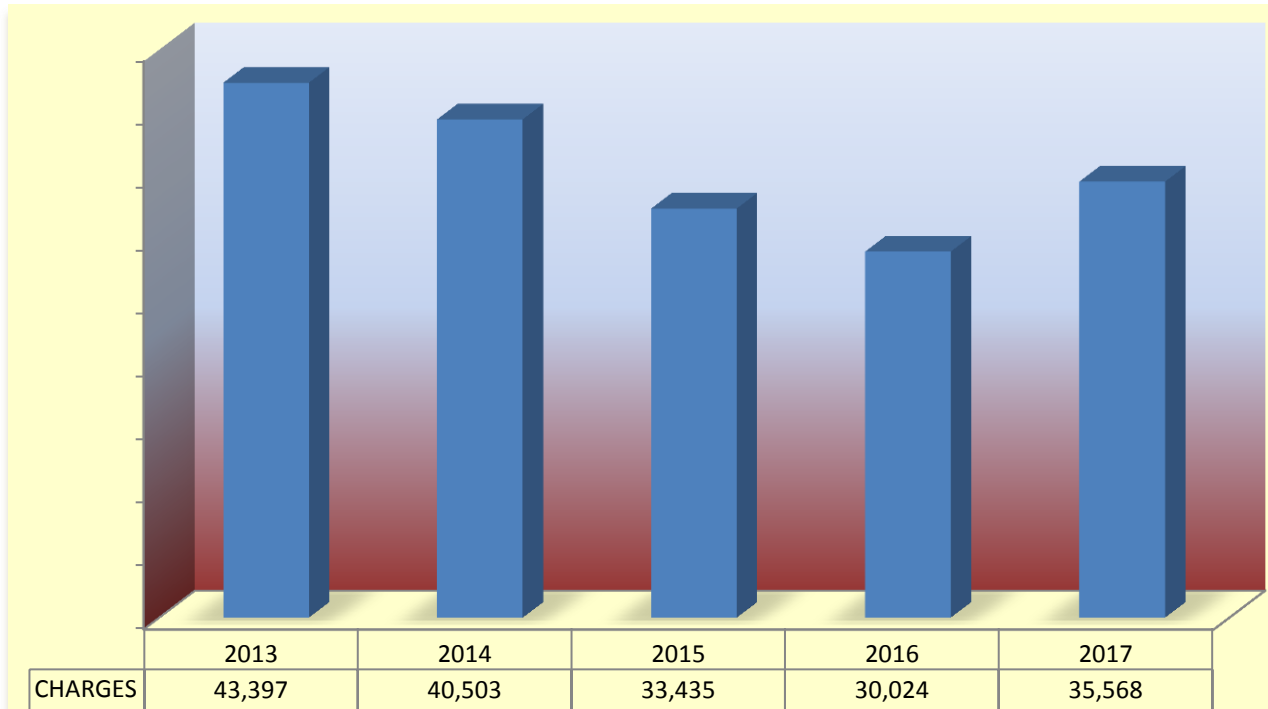

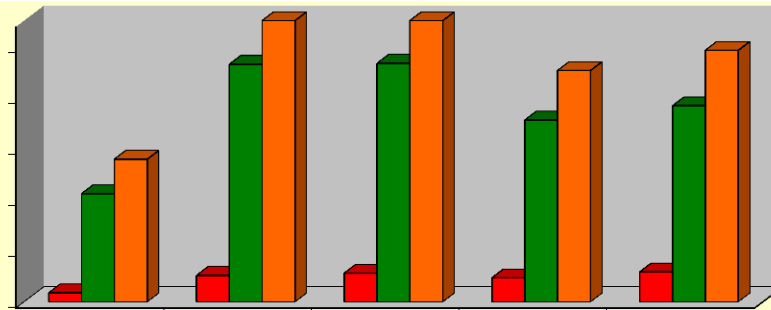

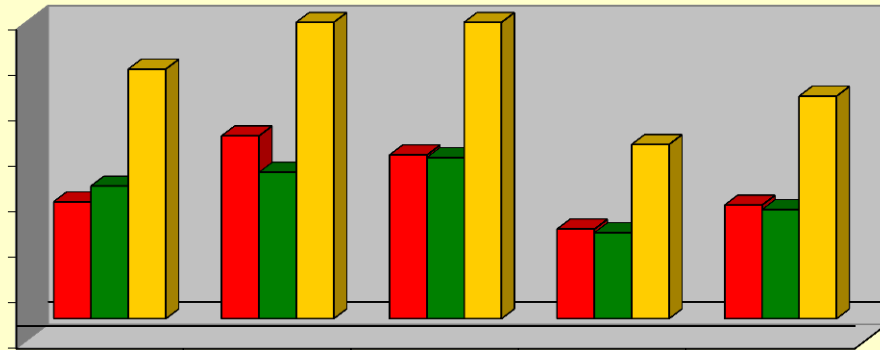

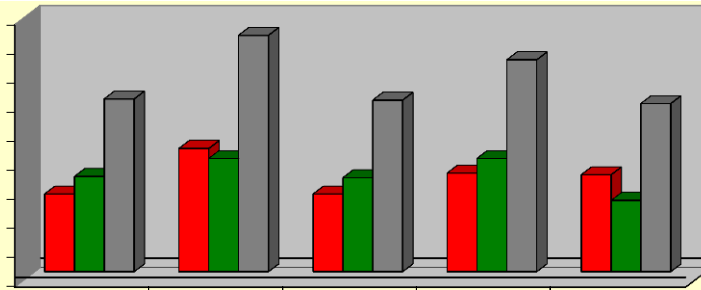

The first time Offender Diversion Program is a short-term intensive period of supervision designed to assist eligible defendants whom the Court determines are unlikely to be prone to recidivism in changing the behavior that brought them before the Court.

The program is a privilege granted by the Court. It is intended to prevent the creation of a conviction record and to avoid future arrest.

The program is not applicable to defendants accused of any of the following offenses:

- Offenses involving violence or threats of violence;
- Building and property maintenance offenses;
- Operating a vehicle under the influence (OVI); and
- Traffic offenses.

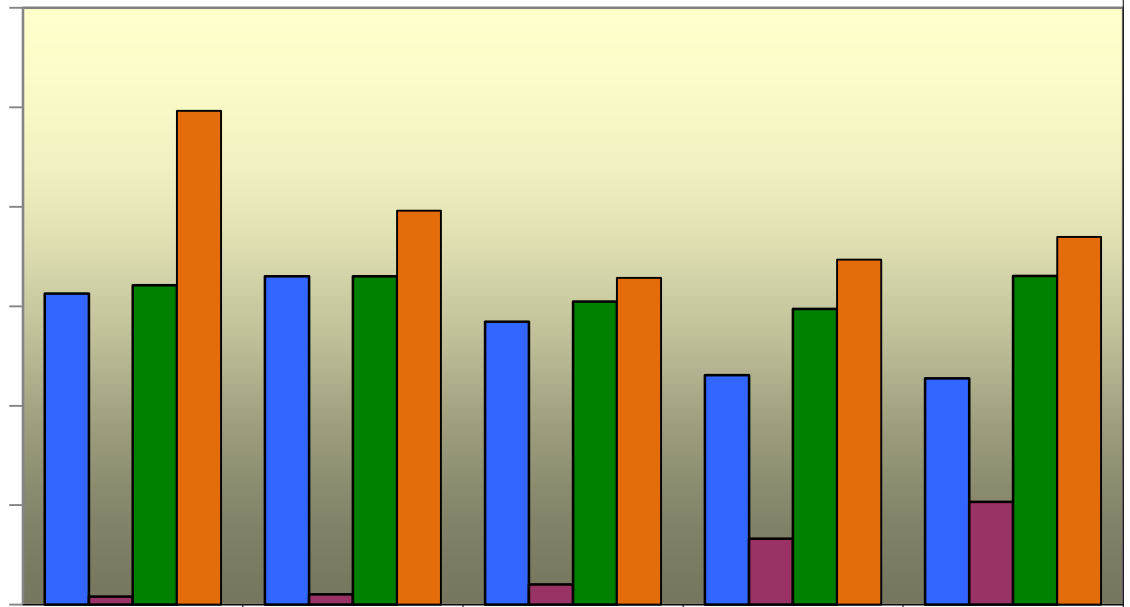

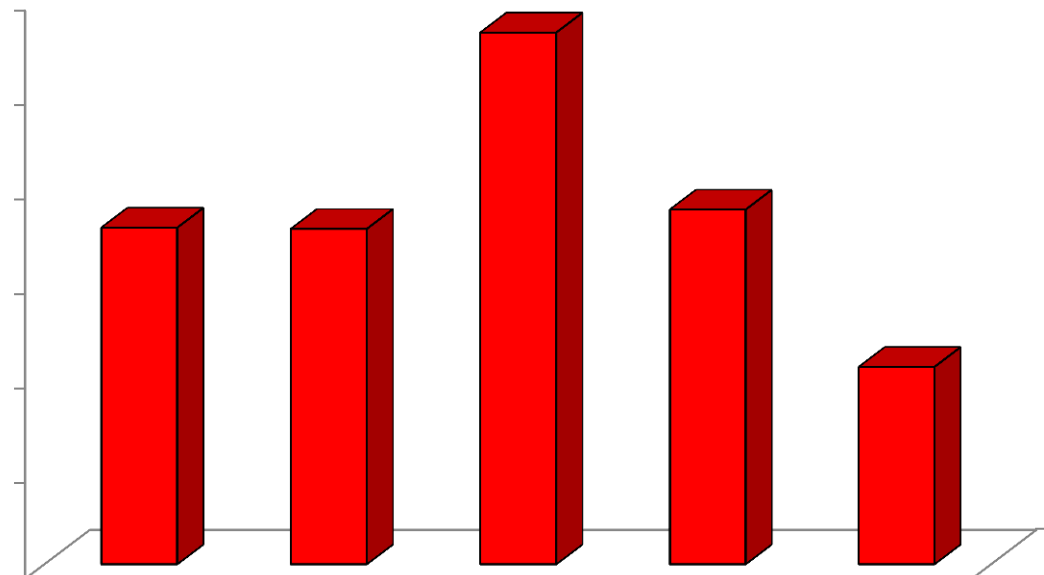
